# **Installing the Back Cushion**

Machines with MyRide® Suspension System Only

#### **Parts Required**


1	Seat back
4	Hex-flange bolt

1. Slide the seat back on to the seat-base posts and align the holes.



2. Secure the seat back using 4 hex-flange bolts and 4 nuts. Torque the bolts to **19.7 N·m (14.5 ft-lb)**.

**Note:** Insert the bolts from back to front. You may need to shift the seat fabric to install the nuts.



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Seat back



## **Attaching the Seat-Tilt Cable**

### Non-MyRide Machines Only

- 1. Tilt the seat back partway.
- 2. Attach the seat-tilt cable from inside the seat pan.



- 1 Seat-tilt cable
- 3. Lower the seat.

## **Setting Up the Motion-Control Levers**

- 1. Locate the motion-control levers attached, but folded down on the machine.
- 2. Remove the upper bolt (3/8 x 1 inch) and loosen the lower bolt (3/8 x 1 inch).
- Raise the motion control levers to the upright position.
- Align the holes in the motion-control lever with the holes in the control-arm shaft, and install the bolt removed previously. Repeat this for both control levers.

**Note:** Hand tighten all fasteners.

- 5. Move the motion-control levers to the park position, raise the seat, and move the control levers back to the center position (neutral).
- 6. Verify that the motion-control levers are properly aligned.

**Note:** Adjust as necessary. Tighten all fasteners.

## Completing the Setup

#### **Parts Required**

1	Key
1	Operator's Manual
1	Operator training material

### **Checking the Mower Adjustment**

Adjust the side-to-side level and the front-to-rear blade slope. Use the relevant procedures in the *Operator's Manual* to verify that the deck is level, and make any adjustments as necessary. Refer to the *Operator's Manual* for more information.

## **Checking the Tire Pressure**

Check the front and rear tires for proper inflation; refer to Checking the Tire Pressure in the *Operator's Manual* for the recommended inflation pressure.

### **Checking the Side-Discharge Chute**

Remove the packing restraint holding the side discharge chute up and lower the chute into place.

## **Organizing the Material**

Keep all the following items with the machine:

- Ignition key
- Operator's Manual
- View the operator training material before operating the machine

### **Charging and Installing the Batteries**

Ensure that the battery packs are fully charged and installed; refer to Charging the Battery Packs and Installing the Battery Packs in the *Operator's Manual* for more information.
